

Additions/Changes to the Agenda: Motion to accept the agenda as presented by Bonnie H., seconded by Jodie. Carried.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: A motion to approve the minutes from 10/15/19 meeting with following addition made by Larry, seconded by Bonnie D. Carried.

ADDITION TO OCTOBER MINUTES: Discussion held regarding the ELCA Resolution regarding White Supremacy.

TREASURER'S REPORT: A motion to approve the Treasurer's Report was made by Rob, seconded by Shelly. Carried.

#### STAFF REPORTS:

- A. Pastor Mytch: Pastor's Report distributed for review. New Member orientation and welcome will be rescheduled in January. Possible dates for orientation are 1/9 or 1/16 and welcome on 1/12 or 1/19.
- B. Jay: Joint Youth Activities with Moe are going great! Jay will provide communion to Bethel-Stafford the first Sunday in December. Family Fun Night Potluck & Scavenger Hunt will be 12/18/19. Jay will be on vacation 12/26 thru 12/30. Jay was thanked for all his work at the school recently and for a very successful Trick or Trunk Event.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

- A. Parsonage/Housing: Pastor Mytch is living in an apartment Her belongings need to be moved to the heated garage. Shannon Carlson (Moe Chair) and Keith will find a work night to get this accomplished. Keith will follow-up with John Wahlberg from the property committee on the parsonage situation.
- B. Sound System & Computer Upgrades: Marty reported that he is working on proposal & questioned the budget amounts available for 2019. New laptops for Jay, Sound Booth and Pastor's office need to be purchased at estimated \$1,000 each. Cost for upgrading the sound system is approximately \$700. A motion was made by Bonnie H., seconded by Allen to proceed with sound upgrade and computes up to \$4,000 with Executive Committee approval if costs come in over this amount. Motion carried. Upgrade for hearing aid proposal will be forthcoming.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Grocery Cards: Cards have been available in the past for families requesting extra assistance. After discussion, decision to discontinue issuing cards and refer those families inquiring to the appropriate organizations Food Shelf, Salvation Army, Social Services, etc.
- B. Bishop Tesch Bishop will be in Roseau on 12/22/19 to preach at both churches. Joint meal will be served at Moe following their service at Noon. Keith and Shannon will work with respective councils to organize this event.
- C. Mission & Outreach Funds (Thanks-For-Giving Basket Fundraiser) Distribution: Approximately \$3,700 raised in the basket fundraiser. After discussion, a motion was made by Allen, seconded by Rob to distribute as follows:

- E. 2020 Budget Prep: Allen and Aimee will meet to prep the budget with assistance from Keith and Pastor Mytch.
- F Annual Meeting Date: Wednesday, 1/22/20 is set with soup and sandwich meal (prepared and served by Council members) with Annual Meeting to follow at approximately 7 PM. Bonnie D. and Bonnie H. volunteered to plan meal. \*\*\*Note this meeting date was changed to January 26th at the December council meeting\*\*\*
- G. Pastoral Services Pay: Pastor Mary Giltvedt has requested reimbursement for providing pulpit supply this past summer. Decision to pay her according to the ELCA guidelines.
