Please note that our Advisory Board meeting scheduled for today has been cancelled. A further meeting date is in the process.

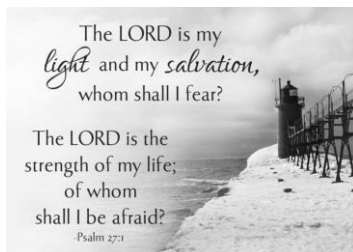
