A few quick announcements:

- <u>Virtual BINGO and Taco Bell on Tuesday, June 16th at 7:00 pm:</u> Immediately following our devotion and prayer time we will play 3 rounds of Virtual BINGO. We will use the exact same meeting ID for every zoom session. That meeting ID is 981 789 4849. Calls can be made with an IPOD, phone, computer, or tablet. Video feed is completely optional.
- <u>Virtual MYF on Sunday, June 21st at 10:00 am (Father's Day)</u>: We will alter our MYF time to 10 am to hopefully have more youth in attendance since Sunday is Father's Day.
- Beach Trip on Saturday, June 27th: We have received the ok from Pastor Angela to go to Huntington Beach State Park for a beach day on Saturday, June 27th. The following youth have confirmed they are going: Caroline, Claire, Jessica, Jacob R. Abby, Nicholas, Lauren, Nathalie. Please let me know if your youth is not on the list and is planning to go. We will leave the church at 7:30 am and return at approximately 8:30 pm. I will have coolers of drinks and snacks. Each youth should bring a bag lunch. I will have some cooler space to keep lunches cool, if needed. We will stop for fast food on the drive home. No money for the beach or for dinner on the drive home is needed. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a waiver form will need to be signed for each youth to go. I will have copies available once you arrive at the church. We are planning to drive personal cars. If any parents would like to go and would be willing to help drive, please let me know. Youth are encouraged to bring any beach toys, balls, tents, umbrellas, boogie boards, etc.
- In-person MYF on June 28th: On June 28th we will host our MYF at the church picnic shelter from 5:00 pm 6:00 pm. The plan is to maintain social distancing guidelines.
