HURRICANE SAFETY



Hurricane season officially starts June 1st and lasts until November 30th. Make sure you know where all of the evacuation routes are. Always listen to the radio and television for the latest information and instructions for your area.

A HURRICANE WATCH issued for your area could indicate hurricane conditions within 36 hours.

A HURRICANE WARNING issued for your area indicates that sustained winds of at least 74 mph are expected within 24 hours. Once this WARNING has been issued, you and your family should be in the process of completing protective actions and deciding the safest location to be during the storm.

BEFORE A HURRICANE:

- Have a disaster plan.
- Have a pet plan (Contact your veterinarian or local humane society for information on preparing your pets for an emergency).
- Know where all the evacuation routes are.
- Prepare a disaster supplies kit for your home and car.
- Have enough food and water for at least 3 days.
- Include a first aid kit, ,canned food and a can opener, bottled water, battery-operated radio, flashlight, protective clothing.
- If emergency managers say to evacuate, then do so immediately.

- Have a NOAA weather radio handy with plenty of batteries, so you can listen to storm advisories.
- Make sure your car is filled with gasoline.

DURING A HURRICANE:

- Stay away from low-lying and flood prone areas.
- Always stay indoors during a hurricane, because strong winds will blow things around.

AFTER A HURRICANE:

- Stay indoors until it is safe to come out.
- Check for injured or trapped people, without putting yourself in danger.
- Watch out for flooding which can happen after a hurricane.
- Do not attempt to drive in flooding water.
- Stay away from standing water. It may be electrically charged from underground or downed power lines.

Don't drink tap water until officials say it's safe to do so.
