A few quick announcements:

- In-person summer field trips During our call last night, a few youth asked about the possibility of the group planning a summer field trip (e.g. Carowinds, water park). I explained that the church has developed a re-entry team to make decisions about in-person ministry gatherings. Carowinds and Neptune Water Park are still temporarily closed and the tentative open dates are not available on their websites. As this information becomes available, we are more than happy to present these ideas to the re-entry team and determine safe ways to plan a field trip.
