General Rules of the Eastern Navajo Fair Parade Entries:

Theme: "STARTS FROM THE EAST"

Parade Schedule:


- Parade Line Up will begin at 7 AM from Crownpoint Chapter road going west and south towards the Elementary School
- If you are not in line by start time, your entry will be placed at the back of the line.
- The Parade will commence promptly at 9:30 AM.
- Your entry number will be handed to you before the parade begins.

Parade Route:

- The Parade will begin in front of the Elementary School and BIA Building. The Parade will proceed west to first intersection and then north towards the second intersection and continue to head north up to the Fire Station and turn west at the ODY intersection and end there. Proceed to the front of the Mid School Building where everyone will park side by side to avoid heavy traffic. Always take precautionary measures while driving.
- The **Bands** will line up in front of the Post Office using the south side of the street.

Parade Guidelines:

- We look forward to a successful Eastern Navajo Fair Parade. This will greatly depend on entries such as yours. As a participant of the parade, we require that you adhere to the guidelines, for the safety of all participants and parade spectators.
- The parade theme should be prominently displayed on your entry.
- The parade entry number(s) can be picked up the morning of the parade. Place your number on the front left hand side of your entry where it is visible for the judges.
- Make sure you provide water for yourself and your participating members.
- Make sure your motor vehicle have plenty of gas during the parade to avoid an empty tank.
- Individuals seated on top of a hood, should use anti-skid pad or rope to avoid a fall.
- Fire Extinguishers are required for each float for safety reasons. Make sure they are up to date, charged and accessible and have a minimum capacity of 5 lbs.
- Safety chains at the trailer hitch must be utilized.
- All entries must keep 40 ft. of space from the entry at the front to avoid cluttering.
- **DO NOT THROW TREATS, WATER, FRUITS, ETC** from the vehicles. No heavy objects are to be thrown to the public. Walking participants may hand out items.
- Horse Riders are required to have hauling permits and health certificates. Make sure
 your horse is trained to tolerate loud noise and big crowds. The group leader is
 responsible for a spooked horse.
- You are responsible for any trash and debris left on the float.
- All entries for the parade are Non-Refundable, regardless of the circumstances.
- The winners will be announced on Saturday afternoon at the Rodeo. It will be posted at Basha's Grocery Store and at the Fair Grounds. Awards can be picked up on Saturday afternoon. Place will be announced.
