

For the months of February and March the Center received almost \$8,000.00 in our <u>**C**</u>entral <u>**A**</u>venue <u>**R**</u>esource <u>**D**</u>rive.

There were 11,621 pounds of food, many extra contributions, and some matching funds collected during that time helping make this year's drive a success.

For many years we received funds from a Feinstein Grant. This grant is no longer available but with your generosity we have continued to restock our pantry, buy perishables, and obtain food supplies necessary to feed those in need that come through our doors. Thank you all and remember us during your busy summer.


