MANY OBEY THE GOSPEL IN INDIA

While it seems in many places, people are turning a deaf ear to the Gospel, it is encouraging to witness firsthand **many obeying the Gospel of**



Christ in India.

On November 17, 2008, R a y & Brenda Maples, their g r a n d s o n Dylan Coo-

per, along with Jerry Manning and I left Memphis enroute to Kakinada, India. Here we would meet up with local evangelists Joshua and Ricky Gootam (father and son). Joshua Gootam was converted to Christ back in 1964, having studied the Basic Bible course authored by the late Ira Y Rice, Jr. and then personally studying with the Late J.C. Bailey, (who had been influenced by brother Rice to move from Canada to India). Joshua was trained by J. C. Bailey to preach the Gospel and for many years has dedicated himself to the faithful proclamation of the Word of God. Ricky Gootam has just recently returned to India having received several years of education here in the States. Although he has a business degree, he wisely decided to go back to his homeland and preach the unsearchable riches of Christ. Additionally, he also operates a "Children's Home" where he helps take care of

some 55 children. Brother Joshua preaches 3 times a week on Satellite Television. During his broadcast he offers the free Basic Bible Courses free to anyone who is interested in studying the Word of God. In response to this offer, he receives some 300 requests a day for the Bible course! It is truly amazing the number of people who wish to know God's Word! There have been more than 3 million people who have completed the Basic Bible Course. When a person completes the Bible course, they are given a "Certification of Completion" and a complete Bible. But, the story continues - not only does Joshua preach on Satellite TV, he also publishes 11,000 issues of a free monthly magazine entitled "The Word of Truth." Joshua laughed when he reported to me that if he is late getting the latest issue mailed out, people

start calling, wondering where is their Word of Truth magazine. Additionally, Joshua compiles a sermon booklet, which he offers free of charge to the
