

Our program is personalized to meet the need of each client.

While the kids don't actually get to ride the four foot tall horses. They learn how to pet them, groom them and learn how to lead them around. Unlike therapeutic riding programs, this equine program uses the horses to help the students express themselves. Interacting with horses is similar to interacting with other people. Expect that horses are very clear when they express themselves. The kids learn to pick up on non-verbal signals the horses give and that is a challenge for kids with Autism. Some being very frightened of full size horses just fall in love with the mini's.

Horses have enabled some of those with Autism to become more confident and more trusting. They enjoy time to feel love for themselves and others. Even if for only a moment. When an Autistic child feels the unconditional acceptance from a horse, I believe a small part of their soul is healed.





Miniature horses are used in the care of children with disabilities. Years of research has shown that children are 3 times faster in interacting with animals than humans. Children see animals with fascination and are more open to animals than adults. We look forward to helping kids with Autism enjoy them selfs and help them decompress.
