### Rules and Regulations

Entry forms to be mailed to **Allie Veinot** at **30 Henley Road, Chelsea NS B4V 7N3**, by June 8 to qualify for a \$5/class fee or a flat fee of \$25/day to include all classes (excluding Stakes). After the deadline, entry fees will be as follows; \$7/class or a flat fee of \$35/day to include all classes (excluding Stakes). *Stake classes \$10 entry fee, \$15 post entry.*

For the purpose of this show, walk/trot classes are limited to walk/trot horses/riders only. Youth classes are for riders 18 years and under. Open classes are limited to riders 19 years and over. Fun classes and stake classes are open to all riders (excluding the youth and walk/trot pleasure stakes).

Youth riders, 18 and under, must wear a certified equestrian helmet while mounted on their horse or pony. They have the option of wearing a helmet or a hat in the showmanship class. Riders 19 and over have the option of wearing a safety helmet when riding, and will not be penalized.

Showmanship classes can be either English or Western.

Walk/trot classes are just that—no loping/cantering, and riding two-handed is permitted regardless of the age of the horse or rider.

**NEW CLASS** - Entries in the Maritime Bred class must provide a copy of the Horses Registration Paper to prove eligibility. Class will be run as a Pleasure Class followed by a Halter Class. Can be shown either English or Western.

There will be no patterns in the equitation classes.

Patterns will be posted at least an hour before the Showmanship, Reining and Trail classes begin.

Youth riders, 18 and under, are permitted to ride two-handed in their classes.

Classes will be placed to 6<sup>th</sup> place, flat ribbons will be awarded.

Stake classes are \$50 added and pay out will be; 1<sup>st</sup>- 30%, 2<sup>nd</sup>- 25%, 3<sup>rd</sup>- 20%, 4<sup>th</sup>- 15%, 5<sup>th</sup>- 10%.

**Stalls must be cleaned out before leaving. You must provide your own bedding.**

**Timer Fee**

There is a daily timer fee for anyone in a timed class (Barrels, Poles, Down and Back, etc.)

**Trailer Park**

**ASSUMPTION OF RISKS, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

**BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT YOU WILL WAIVE CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!**

TO: Ride For The Ribbon (referred to in this agreement as the "Provider")  
AND TO: ALL PROPERTY OWNERS (PRIVATE, FEDERAL, PROVINCIAL, REGIONAL AND MUNICIPAL

On my behalf, and on behalf of any minor children participating in these activities, for whom I am legally responsible, I agree to the following:

**ASSUMPTION OF RISKS**

I am aware and understand that activities involving these horses involve many risks, dangers and hazards, including, but not limited to the following:

1. Horses, which are powerful and potentially dangerous animals, may change their behavior at any time and may without warning, jump, run wildly, buck, kick, bite or step on people or things.
2. Horses may collide with other horses or objects or trip, stumble or fall even if being led, ridden or driven, or attended to.
3. Negligence (which means, in general terms, a failure to exercise ordinary or proper care) of other riders or drivers, my or my child's own failure to ride safely, within my or my child's ability or within designated areas and trails.
4. Equipment may fail.
5. Weather conditions can change and can sometimes be dangerous.
6. The nature of the terrain can change and has certain risks associated with it including, but not limited to, exposed natural objects, trees, etc.
7. Negligence on the part of A PROPERTY OWNER AND/OR THE PROVIDER OR THEIR STAFF. I am also aware that the risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout the show areas and many are unmarked. I understand and acknowledge that no amount of caution, experience or instruction can eliminate all of the risks involved and I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage and damages or loss resulting there from.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

In consideration of the Provider providing me or my child with their horse show services, and the Property Owners providing me or my child with the use of their property (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Services"), I hereby agree as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I or my child have or may in the future have against a Property Owner or the Provider, and their directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, and volunteers (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as "THE RELEASEES") and TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I or my child may suffer, or that my or my child's, next of kin my suffer as a result of my or my child's use of the services or due to any cause whatsoever. INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREASCH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWNED UNDER THE "OCCUPIERS LIABILITY ACT" ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES;
2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any damage to the property of or personal injury to any third party resulting from my or my child's use of the services;
3. The Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my or my child's heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives in the event of my or my child's death or incapacity;
4. This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of Nova Scotia; and
5. Any litigation involving the parties this Agreement shall be brought within the Province of Nova Scotia.

**PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR & RIDING BOOTS**

1. Proper riding footwear is required by all persons, regardless or age, participating in any horse related activities.
2. ALL MINORS (Horseback riders under 18 years of age) are required to wear a protective high impact helmet.

In entering into this Agreement, I am not relying upon any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees other than what is set forth in the Agreement.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, FROM THIS DAY FORWARD, I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I, MY CHILD, MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND/OR REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES.
