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## OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

## OFFICIAL RULES/SCOREKEEPING

$>$ Teams must turn in their official roster and signed liability release to the Director prior to playing their $1^{\text {st }}$ game. NO EXCEPTIONS!
$>$ Home team will keep the official book and be book of record.
$>$ Each team is responsible for submitting scores to site director.
$>$ Birth Certificates must be available on game site at all times during the tournament.
**Triple elimination championship bracket play with a consolation game or pool (if an even number of teams are entered) format will be used. Either format guarantees 4 games.

## STARTING/ENDING THE GAME

$>$ Coin flip (by umpires) will determine home team. Higher seed team is home during playoffs. $>$ In the event we have a designated HOST team they will occupy their dugout of choice.
$>$ No Infield warm up area is in grass on their side of field. Game time is "Forfeit Time" be ready to play within 30 minutes of scheduled game time. No soft-toss into the chain link fence is allowed.
$>$ Time-Limit is $\mathbf{1 2 U}-1$ hour 45 minute drop dead (revert back to last completed inning) at time.

- EXCEPTION: If Home team ties or takes lead in bottom of inning game score is what is at time.
$>$ Time Limit 14U-18U A Legion 2- hour drop dead (revert back to last completed inning ) at time.
- EXCEPTION: If Home team ties or takes lead in bottom of inning game score is what is at time.
$>$ During the Championship Game there will be NO Time-Limit. Mercy Rules will still apply.
$>$ Line-up: Coaches have the option of batting entire line-up or 9 players using DH (for anyone), or use and EH for a maximum of 10 .
$>$ Game Length $12 \mathrm{U}-=6$ innings. $13 \mathrm{U}-18 \mathrm{U}=7$ innings.
$>$ Mercy Rules applied: 8-run lead after (4inn $11 \& 12$ ) and (5 inn 13u-19u), 10-run lead after 4 inn , and 15 -run after 3 innings.
$>$ TIE GAMES: In round robin or pool play will end in a tie.
$>$ PLAYOFF TIE GAMES: Will end of the game, the "International Tie Breaker Rule" will be used. Last recorded out will be put at 2nd Base and there will be (1) out recorded.
$>$ All teams MUST pick-up their trash and debris following completion of their games.
$>$ All teams are asked to retrieve foul baseballs while playing in a game, if we run out of game balls provided by CEM then teams will supply extras.


## EQUIPMENT

> In 12U- Event USSSA rules will be followed on all equipment. BAT REQUIREMENTS : See website for USSSA rules on bats.
$>\quad$ In 13U -- 19U National Federation High School rules apply on equipment. BAT REQUIREMENTS
Wood Bat Requirements: Wood bats do NOT have to be NFHS/BBCOR certified as long as the bat is wood and meets the maximum $25 / 8$ requirement. Any and all other composite (NO BAMBOO) must have the NFHS/BBCOR stamp on them otherwise unusable. Any non-wood bat tournament equipment must have the BBCOR certification code marked on the barrel of the bat.

## UMPIRES

Umpires will settle all field issues. Any protests will be presented to the Site Director with a $\$ 100.00$ fee, protest must be presented before the next pitch. The game will continue, if the protest is won (TBD later) the 100.00 fee refunded.

## SPORTSMANSHIP

- All players, coaches and fans will be expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanship manner at all times. Heckling, taunting, and disparaging remarks will not be tolerated. That person (s) will be removed from the ballpark. Anyone ejected from a game misses next scheduled game per NFHS rules.

WHEN POOL PLAY USED SEEDING DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

1) Pool Play Record
2) Head to Head matchup
3) Runs Allowed (Maximum 7 run per game)
4) Runs Scored (Maximum 7 runs per game)
5) In the event tie still exists a coin toss will decide it.
~Rules not specifically covered shall follow National Federation High School rules.

## ENTRY EEE REFUND POLICY

Listed below are the standards and conditions of Cascade Event Mgmt. refund policy due to inclement weather or tournament cancellation.

1) No games played due to inclement weather full refund less $\$ 50 \mathrm{admin}$ fee.
2) 1 game played $50 \%$ refund (credits may be offered toward another year fee.
3) 2 or more games played no refund.

A game started counts as a game played

## OTHER REFUND REQUEST:

Because teams frequently transfer entry fees to other tournaments or events entry fees are NOT, automatically granted. We ask teams submit a formal request for any potential refund and it will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
