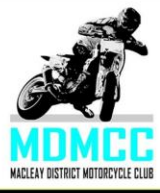

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The above-mentioned open meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Numbers Rd 1 Rd2 Rd3 tba and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.
- 2.2. Day Licenses will be accepted if purchased from Ridernet only. **NO** licences will be issued on the day.
- 2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.
BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries will be accepted on the official on-line entry forms for each round.
- 3.2. Entry fees for rounds 1 and 2 are to be deposited directly to the club as stipulated below Round 3 via ridernet.

11. RACE FORMAT:

SOLO'S

Where there are 12 riders or more.

There will be 4 rounds of qualifying heats of 4 laps, (Slider laps will varied as per track preparation and Steward)

Riders finishing 1st to 10th in the heats will progress to the Final

Riders finishing 11th to 22nd after the qualifying heats will contest the repechage.

1 repechage of 4 laps

1st and 2nd in the repechage will progress to the final

1 final up to 8 laps.

Where there are less than 12 riders the class will be run over 5 rounds of 4 laps

Senior classes with over 24 riders a **Best of the rest final** will be held for riders 3rd to 12th in the repechage and 23rd and 24th places on points. This final must have at least 10 riders to start, and will be held over 5 laps.

SIDECAR and ATV's

Where there are 6 riders or more

There will be 5 rounds of qualifying heats of 4 laps

Riders finishing 1st to 4th in the heats will progress to the final

Riders finishing 6th to 11th after the qualifying heats will contest the repechage.

Where there are less than 6 riders the class will be run over 5 rounds of 4 laps

Race Format:

Central Coast Junior MCC inc . Rd1 Junior. Dirt Track In conjunction with 2020 Central Coast Cup	Non championship class finals over 4 laps JUNIOR CENTRAL COAST CUP: Will consist of 2 or 3 heats depending on entries received of 12 riders with the first 4 or 6 finishers in those heats competing in a one race final. The Central Coast Cup will be run over 8 laps Sunday. SENIOR CENTRAL COAST CUP: Will consist of 3 or 4 heats depending on entries received of 12 riders, with the first 3 or 4 finishers in those heats competing in a one race final. The Central Coast Cup will be run over 8 laps on Sunday. CLOCK ON THE WALL: Competitors who have entered the Junior and Senior Central Coast Cup will receive free entry on the Saturday afternoon to race in (depending on numbers) a 1 lap race with the last three in each heat dropping out until the final three (3) riders competing in a 1 lap final with only first place receiving an award.

12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for *Dirt Track & Track* competition.
- 12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 12.3 Change of machine is **NOT** permitted
- 12.4 Noise &/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.

13. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1 Competitors will be allocated their Motorcycling NSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred riding number if available. All others shall be allocated numbers at the Promoter's discretion.
- 13.2 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

14. GRID POSITIONS:

- 14.1 Grid positions will be pre-drawn and printed in the program.
- 14.2 Grid positions for the repechages/finals will be chosen by the highest point scorer having first choice & so on

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and all participants MUST attend. Random riders' names will be called by the C of C as confirmation of attendance.

16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug &/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

17. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behavior at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

19. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Central Coast Junior MCC Rd 1	The circuit is approximately 533 metres in length: the surface is of loose sandstone construction, rolled and watered. Racing will be in an anti-clockwise direction. Division 1 is dirt track over 375 meters. The surface is of loose sandstone construction, rolled and watered.
Tamworth MCC Rd 2	The circuit is approximately 451 metres in length, the surface is of granite sand.
Macleay D.M.C.C Rd 3	The circuit length is 560 meters and constructed of oiled loam. Racing is anti-clockwise.

20. STARTS:

Central Coast Junior MCC Rd1	All starts will be Speedway style tape start, with a maximum of 12 Solos. Start lights will be used. A green light will be displayed meaning the tapes will release within 5 seconds. If a rider touches the tapes after the display of the green they will be excluded and the event will be re-started. No rolling starts. Starts may revert to mechanical drop forward gates
Tamworth MCC Rd 2	Slide up Speedway type tapes, riders that touch the tapes will be excluded
Macleay D.M.C.C Rd 3	Self-penalizing gates TT Races will be on up to 3 grids of 6 riders with a drop flag to start.

21. RACING:

22. NOISE:

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's and the track licence.

23. PAYG WITHOUT HOLDING:

The Pay As You Go Tax affects the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter may withhold 47% of prize money over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize moneys paid to you.

24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

There will be a Social Get Together on Saturday 31st October; more details on this will be advised in the final instruction for round 3.

- 1. Presentations:** The presentations will take place near the canteens as soon as possible after the final race, EXCEPT at MacClay DMCC where the presentation will be behind the Grandstand near control tower.
