With new COVID-19 requirements the following precautions and practices will be in place:

- Protective Equipment for ALL staff
 - masks,
 - uniform
 - gloves (when food handling or engaging students physically)
- All staff will be trained and expected to practice:
 - Physical distancing when possible
 - Proper cough and sneeze etiquette
 - Frequent hand washing
 - Cleaning and disinfectants of high traffic surfaces
 - Staying at home when ill
- Health Assessment upon arrival, for all students and staff
 - -Temperature taking
 - -wellness questionnaire





- Reduced numbers and Ratios creating limited groups of 10:
 - 8 campers/classroom with 2 Staff
 - 2 groups in 2 classrooms (Maximum capacity)
 - 1 front desk staff, 2 student relief volunteers (for Sanitizing)
 - Camp groups will rotate through the playground space individually
 - Campers will be required to wear masks during play sessions but not during class time where physical distancing can be maintained
- Physically distanced, assigned seating for mealtime and work periods (individual supplies kit)



- Multiple Sanitization Stations
- Routine hand washing routines before and after meals and play sessions



- Increased cleaning and disinfecting routine: As per Public Health recommendations
 - Playground structure will be cleaned in between each group's use
 - High traffic areas will be cleaned 2 times daily
 - Classrooms will be cleaned 2 times daily
 - Bathrooms will be cleaned 2 times daily (intermittently as required)
 - Eating areas will be disinfected before and after use.
