


PICKLE DISH WORKSHOP


for Beginners and Beyond

This workshop is designed to teach the fundamentals of foundation piecing and curved piecing to all students, to share tips, tools and techniques that make the process more simple, and to help the student feel more confident with their foundation piecing and curved piecing skills.



Starting with a simple foundation pieced block with curved edges, I teach the student to sew "by the numbers" to create the basic design. For students that have already grasped the fundamentals of foundation piecing, additional optional blocks are provided so they can create a more complex design or they can choose the more simple block and learn to mix complex colors and patterns together to create a scrappy design. Below are optional blocks available. Other design options may be available at the time of class.







In addition, students will learn the fundamentals of curved piecing with additional tips for getting the most out of your curved pieces. All students should be able to complete 1-2 blocks in class Advanced students may manage to complete more blocks depending on their option. Kit includes: pattern booklet, pattern pieces, Nested Petal Curve template, Nested Petal Curve Companion template, and Folding Friend.

My goal is that every student comes away from class learning at least two new tips whether about the project itself, sewing tips or color theory tips. I hope you will join me to learn these techniques. Remember... every instructor teaches differently. Even if you have tried these techniques before and found they are not for you, I hope you will try out my instruction techniques and see if it changes you mind about the process.
