It has been a very busy March. I have taught 3 workshops and done 2 demonstrations, joined the Quilters Guild and worked on my exhibition art.

Found the perfect fabric for my Evil Queen costume, it's a black and silver white brocade upholstery fabric with a large repeating filigree pattern. I have a sheer black fabric with an opaque pattern to overlay at the front which I will freehand bobbin work decorative purple threads over. I also got some nice antique gold chain like cord at the Stitching Circle for the sleeve and collar detail.

Had heaps of fun at the two day Backgrounds and Beyond workshop at the Embroiders Guild. 6 ladies painted and manipulated tyvek, evolon, sizoflor, plastic, cellophane, lutradur, crash and more. We painted Texture magic shrinking fabric then stitched light weight painted Lutradur over the top. Shrinking the Texture Magic buckles the Lutradur then you can cut away patterns in the Lutradur with a soldering iron to reveal the Texture Magic.

I went to my first Quilters guild meeting and Suzanne Gummow had me on stage to help with the Dare to Differ quilt display.

Taught Freehand Machine Embroidery at The Stitching Circle with 6 students. Visit Ground for Coffee next door for an amazing vegetarian frittata and chick pea salad!

Almost finished my Essence portrait artwork. It's titled "Pyrolysis & Perfume" wondering what pyrolysis is.... google it in reference to fire!
