4. Keep the Word of God in the heart ([Lk. 8:12](#); [Jn. 15:7](#)).
5. Do not fall away, but be rooted and grounded in truth ([Lk. 8:13](#); [Col. 1:23](#); [2:6-7](#); [Heb. 3:6,12-14](#); [12:14-15](#)).
6. Obey the Word of God ([Lk. 8:15,21](#); [Jas. 2:14-23](#); [Rom. 1:16](#)).
7. Bring forth fruit in perseverance ([Lk. 8:15](#); Galatians 5:22-23; [Jn. 6:27](#); [15:1-8](#)).
