

Tips for choosing better sunscreens

- Check products against EWG's sunscreen database and avoid those with harmful additives.
- Avoid products with SPF's higher than 50+
- Avoid sprays. They don't provide a thick and uniform coating on skin and pose inhalation concerns.
- Stay away from vitamin A. Government studies link the use of retinyl palmitate, a form of vitamin A, to the formation of skin tumors and lesions when applied to sun-exposed skin.
- Avoid oxybenzone., a widely used UV-filtering chemical that is a hormone disrupter and allergen.
