## Action Items from Last Meeting

- Veronika stated that we still need to send ½ the honorarium cost for P Sealy to Tau Upsilon for the Mar 7<sup>th</sup> event. That has now been done.
- Also need to reimburse Carolyn Davies for Cathy Crowe's stay at Carolyn's bed & breakfast. This has been done.

Budget: Veronika stated that there is approximately \$5562 in the account. She has put in a request for regional development funds for our nursing week events, ie the nursing week insert in the Windsor Star, the Lois Fairley award costs, promotional mugs (see below). It is for approximately \$1000 It was decided that we will put in our own Essex chapter ad for the nursing week insert. It will be for the least expensive one - \$310.28 plus HST.

- March 30<sup>th</sup> Policy & Political Action Dinner 27 people attended. Crystal Avolio presented good information about the importance of political action. There was much discussion & different scenarios were presented to allow for interchange with the attendees. Crystal & Jennifer felt that there is still much more that could be presented / discussed & we will possible have a "part 2" in the fall. It was held at "the other place catering centre". The food & atmosphere were both very good, & we agreed that we would certainly use that facility again.
- AGM Veronika & Pat attended the AGM, as well as Jamie Crawley from the University of Windsor. The Essex chapter's resolution passed which was "that RNAO head office will undertake a review of the RNAO's internal processes to identify an efficient,

transparent process that provides a more timely response to nurses & employers & includes an evaluative component."

Premier McGuinty spoke & announced that their government will introduce legislation that as of July 1<sup>st</sup> this year, NPs will be able to discharge patients & as of July 1<sup>st</sup> 2012, NPs will be able to admit patients.

# April 18th Supporting Carolyn' Moratorium on Nuclear Power:

- Jennifer will attend the council meeting in Amherstburg & make a brief presentation requesting a moratorium on any further nuclear power plants until more research is done. Other interested RNAO members are invited to attend and support.
- Lois Fairley Award many flyers have been distributed to hospitals, the health unit, Cancer Clinic, long-term & retirement facilities. Jennifer was interviewed by AM800 & there was an article in the Windsor Star April 5<sup>th</sup> asking for nominations from the public. Jen will contact Tony Doucette on the "early shift" at CBC re interview. Nominations are to be sent to Pat McKay, who will then "white out" identifying data & John (Lois' son) & Jennifer & Lynda can choose the winner. The award will be given Tuesday May 10<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 at WRH.
- RNAO Promotional Mugs discussion re the cost of purchasing mugs with the RNAO logo on them which can be used as door prizes for events, or used to give out as a thank you for various reasons. Decision made to purchase the minimum of 72 mugs with coloured logo from Allegra printing. Jennifer will contact them for an updated quote with coloured printing. Veronika will add this cost to the regional development funding request.
  - Jennifer had contacted RNAO head office & found out that they no longer supply promotional mugs.
