Performance Make Up & Hair

Make up - What you'll need:

- Liquid or stick foundation (e.g Pan stick)
- Soft sponge applicators
- Powder base that matches your skin tone
- White & Brown eyeshadow.
- Waterproof liquid black or brown eyeliner or Kohl pencil
- Waterproof mascara
- White highlighter pencil
- Rosy blusher or Bronzer
- Red lip liner
- Red lipstick

Make up tips:

Face:

- 1. Using a sponge applicator apply the foundation over the face, careful blend in well around the jaw line.
- 2. With a large brush, dust with face powder to set the foundation.

Eyes:


- 1. Using an applicator apply Brown eye shadow to the upper eye lid
- 2. Apply White eye shadow above the upper lid and below the brow line
- 3. Using the eyeliner, line the top eye lid (full or half way) extending the line to 2 flicks which accentuates the eyes on stage.
- 4. Use the white eye shadow to highlight the triangle between the flicks
- 5. Apply a light application of mascara
- 6. Darken the eye brows with a brow pencil if required.

Cheeks

 Using a large brush apply some blusher to the cheek bones

Lips:

- 1. Using the lip liner outline their lips
- 2. Fill using a lip brush for easier application
- 3. Blot and seal if required.



Eye liner: Black or Brown liquid liner Extended along the top lids to flicks at the side



Hair - What you'll need:

- Hair elastics the same colour as hair
- Hair grips Hair coloured
- Bun net Hair coloured (if necessary)
- Hair Gel
- Hair Spray

Hair Tips:

See the website or look on the studio notice board for tips on how to create buns and other hair styles.

You're not alone...

Don't worry if you haven't done it before - there's always someone around who can help. Let Diana, Alex or Carol know if you think you are going to need some help with hair or make up for your child and they can arrange for someone to help.

Ask your fellow Mums or Dads too as they may have some handy hints!

Make up and Hair should be done before you arrive at the Theatre on show day.

It may look a lot, but the make up doesn't have to be costly either as Collection 2000 and some other store own brands are quite reasonably priced and you can use them for next time!
