

COVID-19 Business Advisory Fund – Information for Businesses

- The Government has allocated an additional \$25 million to support businesses through the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The funding is to enable businesses to access expert advice and support.
- Business owners can access up to \$5000 excl. GST per business from the COVID-19 Business Advisory
 Fund: To use with a range of providers;
 - o for a variety of services;
 - o depending on their business needs
 - o For 100% funding, no co-funding is required.
- Regional Business Partner (RBP) Growth Advisors will work with businesses to asses priority needs and provide access to funding for registered services.

Eligibility Criteria for Businesses

Businesses must:

- Have undergone an assessment with a Regional Business Partner Growth Advisor
- Have fewer than 100 full time equivalent employees, and
- be GST registered in New Zealand, and
- have a New Zealand Business Number, and
- be operating in a commercial environment; and
- are a privately owned businesses, or are a Māori Trust or incorporation under the Te Ture Whenua Māori Act 1993 or similar organisation managing Māori assets under multiple ownership.

Non-eligible organisations

- Charitable trusts
- Incorporated societies
