<p>Article I Section 3 <u>Members /Funds</u> “The funds collected from the members shall be used solely for the purpose of improving and preserving Bass Lake and its watershed”.</p>	<p><i>Add The following sentences to the end of the current by-law language:</i></p> <p><i>‘The members will vote on the allocation of membership funds from the treasury for new and existing Bass Lake projects at the Annual Meeting of Members.’</i></p> <p><i>‘Donors who contribute funds in excess of the recommended annual dues may individually direct the funds.’</i></p>	<p>Encourage more people to get involved in FOBL by formally voting on the use of membership dollars to preserve and improve Bass Lake and the surrounding area.</p> <p>Encourage donors and members to develop additional project ideas and contribute funds for the implementation of those ideas by the Friends organization.</p> <p>To make sure that Member voting decisions can be included in the annual Nov/Dec board of director budgeting process, the Annual Members Meeting should occur in Sept/Oct.</p> <p><i>This amendment conforms to the motion passed: “The by-laws will be revised in small increments as needed”.</i></p> <p><i>It conforms to the motion passed: “The bylaw committee will convene to make the 3 main changes to the by-laws into motion form” --this being the 2nd change. It follows in order the previous amendment, Article I Section 2.</i></p> <p><i>This three-column question format is recommended from Robert’s Rules of Order and uses the same format as the first change.</i></p> <p><i>The amendment does not add or subtract any rights to any class of people that are not already recognized by the by-laws.</i></p>
