Our Leader in Development Program (LID) is a course for 14-16 year old campers who want develop their Christian leadership skills in order to have a positive impact on their communities, friendships and families.
 Our staff will encourage and help LIDs to reach their full potential, in an atmosphere that addresses personal issues such as self-esteem, personal goal setting and self-discovery.
 LID's will have the opportunity to enjoy camp, learn and practically apply new skills, create many new friendships and prepare for future leadership opportunities.

PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

Every LID has the opportunity to be involved in the U-turn camp program, and apply the teachings that they have learned. Part of the program will be to serve (i.e. helping with dishes) and the other part will be working with the campers alongside one of our staff.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1) Only highly motivated, dedicated young people who are interesting in a demanding and intense leadership experience should consider applying.
- 2) Fill out both the Leadership and regular applications. Mail both back to us with payment. (This will be fully refunded if we do not accept your application)
- 3) For applicants who have been campers at U-Turn Ranch, acceptance is based primarily on performance as senior campers, and also on the Leadership application. We look for young leaders who in their final summer as campers have been cooperative, energetic, able to get along well with peers, and sensitive to others, and who have also shown some dedication. There is no interview process for U-Turn Campers. Applicants who are new to U-Turn Ranch will receive an interview (in person or on the telephone). Acceptance for them is based on both application and interview.
- 4) Applicants will hear from us about acceptance in a few weeks. Any applicants not accepted receive a full refund.

- Drop off for this program is Monday morning at 8:30 (we can accommodate earlier if needed).
- Pick up is Friday at 5:00.
- Campers sleep in our covered wagons or tents
- Campers must go home the weekend in between for the Saturday and Sunday.
