To All Post Commanders and VFW-AZ Council of Administration,

Good day, comrades, my name is Mike Pearson, and I am the appointed Public Servant Award Chairman for VFW-AZ for the current Post Year. The purpose for this email is to distribute the materials necessary for Post Commanders to submit, to me, deserving candidates for the VFW National Awards for Public Servant, in the areas of police, fire, and emergency medical services.

The hard dates as listed are 1 January 2020, to submit candidates to me, and for Department to judge and submit final candidates to VFW National by 1 February 2020. With that being said, I invite all Post Commanders to seek out eligible first-responders in their communities, and honor them in this manner.

As a personal note about me, I am a retired career fire department captain and move-up battalion chief, so this project is very near and dear to me. I have had a submitted candidate receive a VFW National award in the past, from our Post, so I have some experience with the process. I will be so bold to say that, as long as I am involved with the VFW in the future, VFW-AZ has a permanent chairman for this project.

The form is straight-forward to fill out, but I will give some quick-and-dirty guidance that will smooth the way. Seek out the PIO (public information officer) from whatever agency you solicit for this program, and get a suitable candidate. It is helpful to have the candidate's chain of command submit a letter of endorsement for whatever action they are being recommended for. It can be a body of service over time, or it can be an impact award for a single action, whatever is appropriate. When I do this, I give the agency the latitude to screen a single candidate for each category, that saves me from having to do any first-level judging, and this should be first awarded at the Post level. So, if you submit, it should be just one candidate from each category. Don't forget to have a ceremony at the Post level to honor these people, it's a great opportunity to be involved with your community.

The obvious sources are police, sheriff, and fire departments, but do not forget about private ambulance companies which still provide a large amount of EMS response in many communities. Do not forget about volunteer first-responder agencies in smaller communities as well, they are no less important. I have worked, in 35 years of career time, in paid and volunteer positions, private ambulance, career fire service, and a short stint with a sheriff's office (before I went to the dark side of fire service, lol).

So, my hard date for Posts to submit to me is no later than Friday, 3 January 2020, I am extending by a couple of days because having a 1 January deadline is impractical because of the New Year, in my opinion. My only stipulation is that I prefer to receive submissions by email (scan all documents please), it is much easier to storehouse the documents, and give me more time to focus on the important task of judging the candidates. If you absolutely cannot overcome the tech challenge of scanning and emailing, the address of my Post is in the signature line, but those submissions probably need to be mailed out by the last week of December.

Lastly, I have included the VFW National Life-Saving Award with no instructions, so I will make some. This is an impact award for a single appropriate act, and if you have a member of the first-responder community you wish to honor, fill out the form with endorsements from the appropriate agency and email it to me. There is no time-stamp on this, if you have an opportunity, use it.

In closing, I have worked my entire adult life in the community we choose to honor in this fashion. We of that community are largely humble and just do a dirty and dangerous job that most people cannot, but beyond that we are just doing a job, it's how we are built. For the sake of that, please effort to find the truly stand-out people of this community, and not honor somebody for just "doing the job", it would be a dis-service to us. Kind of sounds like the community of combat veterans, doesn't it?

Comrades, good luck with your submissions, thanks for your time, and have a great day.

PUBLIC SERVANT AWARD CITATIONS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS, LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL AND FIREFIGHTERS

Each year, the Veterans of Foreign Wars selects emergency medical technicians, law enforcement and firefighter personnel to receive VFW Public Servant Awards. Post Safety Chairmen are encouraged to submit a candidate for these awards to their **Department Headquarters by January 1**. The Department must select a single candidate for each of the three awards and submit those to **VFW National Headquarters by February 1**.

NOTE: The only item the National VFW Programs Department requires is the "VFW Department Public Servant Award Citation Request Form" which is now available on the VFW website. You can locate this form by logging in to www.vfw.org and searching under "My VFW" in the Training & Support section.

VFW National Emergency Medical Technician Public Servant Citation:

Any individual, who actively gives emergency medical treatment, provides rescue service or civil disaster assistance as a member of any public or volunteer company organized to give emergency medical care, provide rescue and civil disaster assistance to our nation's citizens.

VFW National Law Enforcement Public Servant Citation:

Any individual who serves in a municipal, county, state or federal unit tasked with enforcement of the laws pertaining to their area of responsibility. This award does not apply to individual employed by private companies or security services.

VFW National Firefighters Public Servant Citation: Any individual who actively fights fires as a member of any public or volunteer company organized to fight fires and give assistance to our nation's citizens.

Criteria for these awards – Candidates must have demonstrated:

- 1) Recognition by their colleagues or those they serve.
- 2) Consistent excellence in the performance of their duties.
- 3) Consistent dedication to their official responsibilities over a period of years and continuous growth in responsibilities and skills within their profession.
