Site Safety Starts Here

Is Your Site Safe?

1/. REMEMBER! Always take time when setting up your perimeter fencing. Fence feet should always be placed on a flat surface where at all possible, this will increase stability for you fence. Remember a couple of extra minutes at the start could save you hours later or costly injury claims. (*Remember Safety Starts Here*)

2/. Fence Feet Ltd have taken the time to issue this guidance sheet on using Fence Feet products, feet, ballast and stability posts in varying wind conditions. These have been tested at the Mira wind tunnel test site and conform to and exceed *categories A.B.& C. BS8442:2006* and should be *adhered to*, protecting both the site workers and the general public. 3/. REMEMBER! Broken or damaged feet should be replaced immediately, (Note) *we do not send out damaged or broken feet!*

4/. REMEMBER! Never use damaged or broken feet, fence or any accessories. Report them to your site foreman or Project Manager however trivial they may seem or contact Fence Feet direct 08000 699 886 (24hours). (*Remember Safety Starts Here*) It is illegal to use damaged or broken goods

5/. REMEMBER! Always use tools, machinery and fencing products that are in a good condition, it may just save your life or your work colleagues!

6/. REMEMBER! If in doubt have it checked out. After-all at the end of a day's work we all want to go home safe to our loved ones.

7/. All feet stack safely and easily please don't leave them lying around your sites when not being used.
