## A few quick announcements:

- In-person summer field trips (Beach Trip): During MYF yesterday morning, I proposed to the youth that we plan a trip to the beach for Saturday, June 27<sup>th</sup>. All youth indicated interest in this trip and most were available on this date. I would plan to leave the church at 7:30 am and return at approximately 8:00 pm.

  Before I make this a firm plan, I would like for each parent to let me know by Wednesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> if your youth is available and can go on this day trip.
