MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 10th, 2019 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with all councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 13th, 2018 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of December were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council acknowledged the Fidelity Bond, authorized Workers' Compensation coverage, set 2019 salaries and wages, approved the transfer of funds, opted out of spring Provincial road bans, set the dates for the Budget Meeting and the Ratepayer's Supper and Meeting, and issued cemetery grants to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery. Council authorized memberships in several organizations for 2019, allocated the R.M.'s population to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2020 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation, authorized the Beaver Control Program for 2019, and directed a tender for the lease of pasture land on NW 19-5-33 W1M to be issued.

Council received two delegations, including a presentation from the SARM Division One Plant Health Officer and a delegation of ratepayers.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of way applications were approved by council for wellsites and approach use.

Correspondence was received and filed.
