

FROM FR. FRANCISCO 'S DESK

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. It was instituted by Pope Pius XI when the "Roman Question" was being fought. In a nutshell, the "Roman Question" was the fight of how much temporal power the Church had over the lands known as the Papal States. This was defined in 1929, when King Vittorio Emmanuelle signed the treaty with Pope Pius XI establishing the Vatican State. Why then we celebrate this feast at the end of the Liturgical year? There are several reasons, but I want to focus in some of them. First, because it is a reminder that no earthly power can take over the Church; it is of extreme importance that the Church has the freedom to appoint the bishops and the Pope to be able not to be attached to any earthly power. Second, to remind us that governments and politicians pass away but Christ words and teachings do not pass away – He is the King forever! Finally, as we close the liturgical year and start looking at the end of times with the first part of Advent, we are waiting and expecting the return of Christ as King with His kingdom to us. Today's feast is an invitation to have Christ as our King and nothing else but Him – Thus, spend some time with God this week making sure that He is the King in your life.



We are going to start the Giving tree, please be generous as you usually are; also, we will have our annual community decorating tree in the Gazebo. Finally, the fest of Our Lady of Guadalupe is fast approaching so mark your calendars for December 12 at 7 PM. On December 8, we will have a youth mass for the feast of the Immaculate Conception at 7 PM – please mark your calendars.


