WHEREAS the parties named above desire to continue to associate with each other for the purpose of further developing and maintaining the park known as the BOW VALLEY PARK established under *The Regional Parks Act*, 1979 and the parties wish to make financial contributions in the amounts of: Town of Oxbow \$5,000.00, R.M. #3 \$2,000.00 and R.M. #33 \$1,000.00 for the period of this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT in consideration of these presents and the covenants, promises, and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties jointly agree as follows:

 TO CONTINUE to associate and work together and appoint representatives to the BOW VALLEY PARK AUTHORITY to further develop and maintain the BOW VALLEY PARK. The municipalities shall appoint the following number of representatives to the Park Authority pursuant to Section 6 of *The Regional Parks Act* and Section 3(e) of the Regulations:

5 representatives

R.M. #3

2 representatives

R.M. #33

1 representative

TO CONTINUE to develop, operate and maintain that area of land now designated as BOW VALLEY PARK and more particularly described as follows:

All That portion of the South Half of Section 23, in Township 3, in Range 2, West of the Second Meridian, which lies southeast of the southeasterly limit of river road as shown on the Plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the Regina Land Registration District as No. Al 579. Excepting firstly: the most easterly 120 rods throughout of the Southeast Quarter of Section 23, Secondly: all that portion as shown as "Beaver Park" on a Plan of Record in the said Land Titles Office as Plan No. AN 1857.

All of the portion of the North East Quarter of Section 14, in Township 3, in Range 2, West of the Second Meridian, described as Parcel "A" according to the Plan of Record filed in the Land Titles Office for Regina Land Registration District as No. 61R024783.

- THE PARTIES each agree to perform and do all acts necessary in order to ratify and confirm this
 agreement and in particular the parties agree to pass a complimentary bylaw authorizing the
 execution and performance of this agreement.
- 4. THIS AGREEMENT shall be renewable as of January 1, 1999 should the municipalities participating under this agreement so desire.
