She is a precious little girl and thankfully she is in good health and putting on weight daily now. We named her Rachel Joy! We now have 5 children in our Children's Home.

We have had several generous gifts over the past few years of clothing and toys for the kids.

We do our best to feed them a healthy diet of good food and teach them the truths of God's Word as they are able to understand. We try to make the atmosphere of our orphanage as 'homey' as possible. The youngest boy, JR, has a 'lazy eye' problem due to a seizure he had before we received him at 5 months old. He is almost 3 years old now and will be getting a pair of glasses this week to help with that problem.
