n December 26, 2004, the day after Christmas, an earthquake measuring between 9.1 and 9.3, the third largest earthquake every recorded on a seismograph, struck in the Indian Ocean, triggering a series of devastating tsunamis, and killing over 230,000 people in 14 countries.


This earthquake was the longest duration ever observed, between 8.3 and 10 minutes. It caused the entire planet to vibrate as much as 1 cm (0.4 inches). The hardest hit area was **Indonesia**, followed by **Sri Lanka**, **India** and **Thailand**.

Following this disaster, a major newspaper printed this article to the *right*, asking the question, "*Where was GOD*" while this horrible disaster took the lives of so many?





So, where was God all this time as people were losing their lives in the




worst natural disaster in history? <u>God</u> <u>was there</u> all the time, even <u>before</u> the news of the dead was announced to the world.

THEN shall they CALL UPON ME, but I WILL NOT ANSWER; they shall SEEK ME EARLY, but they SHALL NOT FIND ME: [WHY?]

For that they HATED knowledge, and DID NOT CHOOSE the fear of the Lord: THEY WOULD NONE of my counsel: they DESPISED ALL my reproof.

Therefore shall they EAT OF THE FRUIT OF THEIR OWN WAY, and be FILLED with their OWN devices.

For the TURNING AWAY of the simple shall slay them, and the PROS-PERITY OF FOOLS shall destroy them.
