

## **After School Program Assistant Internship-Paid**

**About the Internship and Responsibilities:** This Internship is geared towards individuals interested in gaining experience working with youth (most being considered at-risk youth) in a “Trauma Informed School Environment”. Interns will gain a number of skills and tools through Program and Event Planning, Community Trainings, Program Design, Program Execution, Program Evaluation, Civic Engagement, Community Outreach, Research, Needs Assessment, Resource Development, Partnership Development, Networking, and Mentorship. We are looking for individuals who are self-motivated and organized. Individual should have excellent communication skills and a positive attitude. Attention to detail is a must. All majors are welcomed (child development/early childhood education and/or studies, education, sociology, psychology, counseling, criminology and criminal justice studies, liberal studies, or women’s and gender studies majors preferred).

**Hours and length of Internship:** Monday through Fridays, starting Early August through the beginning of June. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays: 2:30-6:15, Wednesdays 1:15-6:15. Additional time as needed for off-site community trainings (which are scheduled in advance to ensure Interns availability).

Some flexibility may be available (i.e. only able to work Monday/Wednesday/Fridays or only Tuesday/Thursday/Fridays, etc. Please call and ask if your schedule can be accommodated.

**About The Workplace:** Kid Street Learning Center was founded in 1992 as an after school theatre arts based program. Kid Street expanded into a Santa Rosa City School District Charter School in 1999 for grades K-6. Kid Street has developed a holistic educational model that supports positive behavior, the love of learning and positive emotional development. We strive to find new ways to expand our program offerings. Our goal is to provide a safe and nurturing environment while our kids discover new hobbies and activities that will both be therapeutic and help stimulate their minds. We provide an academic program where the After School Program Staff and Interns collaborate with the Charter School teachers. Students complete the homework from the school day and then move onto other skill based activities to students on an individual, small group, or whole class basis. Additionally, many small group activities are available for enrichment. These include: arts and crafts, dance, cheerleading, theatre, science club, woodworking, gardening, sports, fashion design, karate, photography, music, group games, and cooperative and individual sports. We are looking for leadership and skills in these areas or any other hobbies and talents that can be integrated into the program.

**HR Requirements:** Background Check and Finger Printing clearance, Application, and Cleared TB Test.

**Compensation and Academic Credit:** This is a paid internship position, with pay based on experience between \$12.05-\$15.79. Students are encouraged to receive academic credit for their internship experience with their academic major or as an elective.
