Budget Update: Veronika reported that there is a balance of \$3540.48 in our account. She circulated a copy of our proposed budget for 2012 & also reported that Nancy Campbell from head office did not need a copy of it.

WFCU Opportunities: Lynda had talked with Jen prior to this meeting & wanted to make the Executive aware of the benefits of belonging to the WFCU and the potential benefits to RNAO Essex Chapter Members. A discussion ensued as to whether it would make sense to also switch our account to the WFCU. Veronika stated that we only pay \$2.25 per month for our account at TD Canada Trust & that the location & TD's hours are more convenient than other banks. Also discussed was the fact that we would also need to purchase new cheques. The general consensus was that we would remain with TD Canada Trust at this time.

Status Update: Stock Photos of Essex Chapter Members: Jen has emailed Rod Dennis, who was recommended by Lynda, as he has done photo work for Windsor Essex Community Health Centre. Jen has asked him for a price quote and is waiting to hear from him.

Status Update: U of W Nsg Student Automatic RNAO Membership: Pat reported that the University of Windsor Faculty of Nursing decided not to include an RNAO student membership fee in their recent referendum. Pat inquired about it & was told that they got feedback from students in the nursing society group that adding the cost of the RNAO membership (\$15) might prevent the referendum from being passed. The Referendum has already taken place. Mercedes will speak to the current nursing society president about this.

Review: Timeline 2012 Chapter Activities: Jen distributed the draft 2012 Timeline for our chapter & discussion followed. A couple items were added. Kelly will speak at a Resume writing workshop at the nursing career fair on Monday Mar 26th. As well, we may have a lawyer come in October.
