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Mission Impact

Mission

To provide educational resources to k - 12 students in San Antonio public schools who lack the necessities for academic success

This section gives insight into what is important to A+ Academic Resources and shows the impact our programs and services have on mission accomplishment. The organization's programs and services are consistent with its mission and tax exempt purpose. As indicated below, our programs are striving to significantly impact the communities we serve.

Academic Resources Program

The Academic Resources Program provides academic resources such as (a) school uniforms, (b) gym shoes, (c) backpacks, (d) books, and (e) school supplies for children to go to school and learn. These resources are provided to children in need. Beneficiaries are students attending public schools, from K - 12 grade. A total of \$3,824 supported 529 students through the Academic Resources Program.

Boysville

A+ Academic Resources donated \$500 to Boysville. This amount was generously matched by the Richmond Family Foundation. Therefore, Boysville students received a total benefit of \$1000 which allowed us to serve 400 students. Our donation provided reading materials to help children break the cycle of illiteracy. We made a \$1,000 impact for Boysville students' academic success.

Child Advocates San Antonio (CASA)

CASA students received the *new* Leapfrog Ultimate School Readiness Tablet which prepares students for school success with a tablet packed with exciting new things to learn and discover. This ultimate kid-safe tablet teaches a wide-range of skills needed for school and beyond such as core school skills, creativity, and problem solving. This smart tablet has **25**+ apps and access to **1000**+ learning games, eBooks, videos, and more. Additionally, this tablet includes **\$100** worth of apps with **10** preschool and kindergarten apps to ensure 3 - 6 year olds are ready to learn!

CASA students also received the Leap Frog Leap Reader. This reading and writing system is the "#1 Learn-to-Read System", the ultimate learn-to-read mega pack with **10** early reading books to spark a love of reading for ages 4 - 8. This super tablet helps students learn to read and write: a) sound out words and read sentences; (b) build skills with fun interactive stories; and (c) listen on the go with audio books.

Additionally, CASA students received the Leapfrog Shine with Vocabulary Language and Communication Skills for curious 3 - 6 year olds. Students learn how to (a) join two words to form compound words, (b) use verbs to describe action, and (c) identify high-frequency sight words.

CASA students also received the Leapfrog Math in Action with Listening Skills for curious 4 - 7 year olds. Students learn how to (a) create number sentences, (b) identify shapes and symmetry, and (c) interpret data in a graph or chart. Finally, CASA received an HP Pavillion laptop (\$822) to add to its' library/student resource center. This new acquisition provides another computer for students to complete their homework and school assignments. A total of \$1,159 was spent on technology academic resources for 57 CASA students' academic success.

San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD)

SAISD received \$750 for educational resources such as books for classrooms to enrich the learning experience for 37 students. A+ Academic Resources participated in the 2019 Run 4 Education. With a \$500 donation, we sponsored a school that has 25 students in dire need of resources for academic success. Additionally, 10 students received gym shoes (\$415) which allowed the students to fully participate Physical Education class. A total of \$1,665 was spent on SAISD students' academic success.

Funding the Mission

Fundraising is mandatory for nonprofit organizations since they rely heavily on in-kind donations to obtain needed resources to provide mission-essential programs and services to those in need. The A+ Academic Resources Board and Staff gave \$3,024 and raised \$800 in donations to fuel the organization's mission, programs, and services. We will continue to invest our time, talents, and treasures to provide academic resources and educational experiences to achieve students' academic success.
