During the 40-week school year, Friday Fill-Up! provide 50 children in food insecure households an extra boost of nutrition: a backpack with 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, and 3 snacks. They also provide an item to help the family stretch their food budget. Breakfast includes cereal & milk or oatmeal; lunch might be canned pasta or soup. An applesauce cup and fruit cup along with 2 vegetable cups are included each week. Snacks include goldfish, granola bars, snack crackers, and occasionally some cookies. The extra item for the family includes a full-size box of macaroni & cheese, tuna & tuna helper, or a box of spaghetti and sauce. All items are shelf stable, easily opened, nutritional. balanced and kid approved. \$1200 feeds all 50 kids for a month. It is our objective to raise at least that much for Friday Fill-Up at our Square Dance Fundraiser this year. Encouraging your friends to Saturday, April 4th and taking time to bid on fun-to-win items in both the silent auction and the raffles will make that happen. Do it for the kids!


