## Supply List:

Sewing machine in good working order, do not forget power cord
1/4" foot
Single-hole throat plat is helpful
Rotary cutter \& mat
Marking tool (Mechanical pencil, regular pencil, etc.)
$4 \times 8$ ruler
6" or 7" square ruler
Acrylic table for your machine, if you have one
Normal sewing supplies, thread, pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.

## Fabric Requirements:

This quilt was made with the controlled scrappy method. This means that each piece of fabric "C1" for example would be the same color family, but not necessarily the same fabric. You could do this in just four (4) different fabrics, but the look would not be as dynamic.


## Cutting Instructions: Place a color Swatch in each box for a sample reference.

5 each $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
4 each 3 " x 5 1/2" rectangles
18 each 3 " squares, 12 each 3 " $\times 5$ 1/2" rectangles
