## Finance/Administration.

Working towards the grant application re Improving Local Places.

#### General Maintenance.

Maintenance Contractor requested to undertake additional works as per the October minutes.

#### Rectory Lane.

Local meeting held on 9 October 2017 (ECC, Parish Councillors and local residents) where it was agreed to proceed with 'Quiet Lane' status, which should be introduced by 31 March 2017. It was also suggested that an additional submission be made to the BDLHP for the following to be introduced: signs indicating 'Lane unsuitable for HGVs'; signs indicating 'Road Narrows'; a 20mph speed limit to be introduced for the whole of Rectory Lane. This submission to be considered/approved by the Parish Council at the November meeting.

#### Rivenhall Airfield - IWMF.

Communication sent to ECC recommending that the two outstanding planning applications be refused. Failing that, due to the on-going planning creep associated with this site, there should be a fresh public Planning Inquiry.

A one-day public exhibition has been arranged for Thursday 2 November 2017, between 3.00 pm and 7.30 pm at Bradwell Village Hall.

#### Colemans Farm Quarry.

Correct updated temporary traffic routing information for HGVs accessing the site issued by the operators.

The operators confirm that the site doesn't operate before 07.00 nor should there be any HGVs on site before this time. They say "We are not aware of any HGVs having been on site before 07.00 - indeed it should be physically impossible."
