

## <u>Newborn Waiver</u>

CONGRAULATIONS on the newest addition to your family!

Many new parents are unaware that babies are not automatically covered on al insurance plans. However, some insurance plans do indeed automatically cover newborns for the first 30-31 days until you can get in the information necessary to add the newborn.

You may have to check with your HR department or member services to see how your individual health plan works and to begin the process of adding your baby to the insurance.

If the newborn coverage period has ended, and the newborn is not showing active on an insurance policy, you will be responsible to pay out of pocket costs for the visit.

Lastly, if your child has been added to an HMO, CHIP or Medical Assistance Plan, it's imperative that you have CareVIIle Pediatrics P.A or Ifeanyi Mbadugha listed as the PCP.
