Dear Friends and Colleagues, Welcome to the inaugural Newsletter

for the NR-SIG-WFNR.

The origins of the Special Interest Group in Neuropsychological Rehabilitation (SIG) grew from a lunch time discussion between Robyn Tate, Michael Perdices and myself in a winery in the Hunter Valley, Australia in 2003. We decided to hold a satellite meeting on rehabilitation following the International Neuropsychological Society's mid-year conference to be held in Brisbane the following year (2004). This first meeting was chaired by Robyn Tate and held in Uluru (Ayers Rock) in July 2004. It was considered by all who attended as so successful that we decided to make it an annual event. From the second satellite meeting, held in Galway, Ireland in 2005, came the idea of a new international group in NeuroRehabilitation. I decided to look into ways this might be achieved and said I would feed back at the third satellite meeting to be held in Liechtenstein in 2006. After considerable debate and gentle persuasion from Michael Barnes, the then president and founder of the World Federation of NeuroRehabilitation, we decided to join forces with the WFNR.

The new SIG was formed in July 2006 and formally announced at the 2006 Liechtenstein meeting. We had, by then, decided that the fourth satellite meeting would be held in San Sebastian, Spain so the inaugural meeting of the WFNR SIG in Neuropsychological Rehabilitation was held there in 2007 after the INS in Bilbao. Although affiliated to the WFNR, we decided to continue to hold our meetings in conjunction with the INS, mostly because the WFNR World Congress Meetings were held every two years rather than annually. At this time we formalised our committee, consisting of Barbara A. Wilson (Chair), Robyn L. Tate (Secretary) and members, Jonathan Evans, Tamara Ownsworth, Michael Perdices and Jennie Ponsford. James Malec joined us later as Treasurer. The 2008 meeting was held in Iguazu Falls, Brazil after the INS in Buenos Aires, Argentina; the2009 meeting was in Tallin, Estonia and the 2010

meeting in Krakow, Poland. We then went back to Australasia, to Rotorua in New Zealand. It was at this meeting that the very efficient Margaret Eagers took over as conference organiser and has remained so ever since. James Malec became treasurer formally at this time. In 2012 our meeting was held in Bergen, Norway followed by Maastricht in 2013 and Cyprus in 2014. The most recent member of the committee is Anna Adlam whose work is with children. Margaret became our new Executive Officer after the Cyprus meeting. We are now looking forward to our next meeting on Daydream Island, Australia in July 2015. Barbara A. Wilson, Chairperson of SIG
