Dear Mr. Gordon:

On December 10, 2018, the Office of the Attorney General (the "OAG") received a public information request under the Public Information Act (the "PIA"), Chapter 552, Government Code, from Mr. Phillip Morris. A copy of the request is attached as Exhibit A.

The OAG will release most of the information with redactions allowed by law. The OAG asserts, however, that the remaining responsive information is excepted from required public disclosure under the PIA. Specifically, the OAG invokes all of the exceptions provided by, and the exceptions incorporated into, sections 552.101 through 552.156 of the PIA.

Pursuant to section 552.301 of the PIA, this letter is submitted to seek a decision on the applicability of the claimed exceptions. To assist in your review, the OAG will provide written comments and the responsive documents not later than the 15th business day from the date the request was received.
