## **Parents Need to Know!!**

Center Hours are 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. At 5:55 p.m. any children still here walk with their Leader to the Front Office.

On Field Trip Days, the summer campers eat breakfast earlier than the regular 8:30. Children must be here on time for breakfast in order to be served. If a child is not here by departure time for the trip, the parent must transport their child to the Field Trip Site or keep the child with them until Campers return.

- DRESS FOR PLAY every day! Summer Campers need to wear the proper \* shoes for playing outside: sneakers and socks are best, but all shoes need to have a back. Children will be DIRTY if they played hard! We encourage children to enjoy outdoors and do not spend time telling them to stay clean; playing in dirt is a fun part of being a child.
- No outside toys are brought in except by request. We allow a "quiet time" \* toy to come, but it should be small enough to fit in a cubby and should not be electronic. Children are responsible to take care of the item and keep it in their cubby until quiet time.
- SWIMMING: Summer Campers swim EVERY DAY that weather permits during the afternoon. Check your Swim Schedule for your group's weekly swim time. Every Summer Camper needs to have swim shoes (crocs, flip flops, or mesh shoes) that will be worn out to the pool, a full size towel, and anything else needed for swimming (goggles, etc). Girls should wear modest swim suits and boys should wear trunks. No Speedos, no sequins, and no fringev suits. All children must swim in swimwear; no swimming in shorts. Children may wear a "rash shirt" over swimsuit if desired-many children wear these sleeved swimshirts daily to help protect from the sun. Extra change of clothes should be kept in child's cubby for the summer. Regular play shoes should be worn daily - NO backless shoes. NOTE: We swim in foggy, drizzly weather, A rainstorm might only prevent swimming for 20 minutes, so plan to swim everyday unless noted on the calendar.
- Parents can expect that their child will be playing outside and swimming \* EVERY day. In extreme temperatures, classes will continue to swim in the afternoon, but afternoon playground time may shortened or cancelled.

NOTE: If a cell phone, tablet, or electronic game is brought in, it will be powered off and kept in the child's bag or brought to the office for parents to pickup that afternoon. No TV viewing will take place during Summer Camp unless noted except the regular 5:25 p.m. viewing. We are UNPLUGGED at Summer Camp! It's the only way to be - welcome to our world of natural fun!
