FAQ

Are your Balloons made of Latex?

Yes our balloons are latex

What age would you recommend a child receive a balloon?

Ages 3 and up are suitable to receive balloons and any younger than that need to have a responsible adult receive the balloon for them and take full responsibility in regards to safety. We will not be responsible for babies and young toddlers who could choke or hurt themselves with the balloons.

How long will my balloon last?

That depends on how well they are cared for. Our Balloons are guaranteed to stay in tact for the first 30 sec or 30ft whichever comes first if no foul play was involved (ex. intentional popping).

How can I preserve my balloon?

Keep it out of heat and direct sunlight, and away from sharp objects.

How many balloons can a child receive?

1 balloon per child, until all children that would like a balloon have received one, and if there is more time then another 1 or more can be made.

How many balloons can I order at once from the balloon twister?

1 balloon at a time for each person in line

Can I have a balloon once the balloon line is closed?

No. Once the balloon artist is completed with the time the host has scheduled for her, she is done and often times has other previous commitments.

Can I request overtime for my event if more people want balloons?

Yes! Absolutely you can, as long as we do not have another event to head to directly after your event and you are willing and able to pay the overtime fee at the time of service.
