Welcome to September!

Junior Achievers Academy welcomes all new and past children and families! I hope everyone had a wonderful summer and look forward to having your children! For starters I have a parent package that will contain a lot of important information. Please read all, and get back to me with any questions and concerns.

For our first week of September after the holiday, I will be familiarizing the children with their daily routines, environment and new friends! I will list out below all that is required for starting at Junior Achievers Academy. For the children's first day they will require:

- Lunch bag with an ice pack for food/drink items that should be refrigerated, water will be provided daily and juice/milk needs to be provided by the family. A labelled water bottle as well.
- The Weekly Snack Menu will be up on the parent board, please check to see that it is okay for your child. If you think they will absolutely not eat something, you may send some back up ideas in their bag.
- 1 knapsack with a large Ziploc bag containing a full set change of clothes that includes socks, underwear, t-shirt and pants. Diapers and wet wipes along with a changing mat for those children that are not quite potty trained.
- A blanket and stuffy for those whom would like to lay down/nap that will fit into the child's knapsack. A tiny pillow as well if they wish.
- Appropriate outdoor clothing, for we would like to get outside daily. Muddy buddies for when the weather gets damp/wet.
- All registration forms fully completed, post-dated checks for the 1st of each month and completed emergency/pick-up contact information.

For the second week I will need a completed Earthquake pack for the group Emergency supply container. In the Earthquake pack the following is needed:

Glow stick, family picture with encouragement letter, small stuffy or toy, water bottle with water sealed, fruit bar, granola bars (both with dates good for 1 year), socks, gloves, hat, emergency blanket (small silver ones from Canadian tire) and anything else, but it needs to fit in the Ziploc bag I provide you, also you will need an Out of Province Emergency Contact.

Attached you will find the September Calendar of themes and events. All through the year we will do All about Me, then Dramatizing Stories, Transportation, Spring, Animals/Insects, going into Farm Animals and Ocean. In addition to the above mentioned themes, we also study the seasons, holidays and some events that are perhaps happening around us in our community.

I am sure I have missed something. Please remember to sign your child in daily. Parking is always available on the street, in visitors or there is one spot #15 next to my

car. Please don't park anywhere else. Most neighbours are kind but you just never know who might complain.
