If there is rain in the forecast, please bring raincoats and boots.

SCHOOL PACKAGE AND PRICIE

School Groups – See student price on cover sheet (If less than 20 students the price is \$25/student)

This includes the following...

- One school day at U-Turn Ranch
- Standard Schedule includes horses, archery, team building and orienteering (scavenger hunt).
 - We can substitute other activities if needed.
 - Pool attempt to have the pool up and running from June-Sept, but there is an extra cost for this as we need to hire a lifeguard. \$5/student
- Dining Hall to eat
- Teachers and parents may attend at no charge.

**Longer days and Overnight packages are available – Please contact office to discuss options.

PROGRAMMING/ACTIVITIES

We generally run 4 different activities and the groups of students rotate through each activity. Note that we adjust our activities and what is taught according to the age that is participating. Therefore, our program can be great for younger and older students. Depending on the amount of time here, will determine how many activities we can fit into the day.

Please see below a brief description of each activity. We do have other options that can be substituted such as Vaulting, Hike and Nature. This is an idea of what can be involved in our program.

Horse/Animals – Horses is a very exciting part of our program at U-Turn Ranch. Depending on what your board will allow, we can do one of the following.

- 1) Riding Option - Each horse activity starts with a brief instruction. Each student will have the opportunity to get up on a horse for a ride. This is led by our experienced horse staff at U-Turn Ranch. While the students take turns riding, the rest of the group will be able to groom and interact with some of the other horses, supervised by parents/teachers if comfortable.
- 2) Animal Class – During this option we allow the teacher to introduce the class to one of our horses. They will teach the class what you should and shouldn't do with a horse. How horses interact with us as humans, and show them the different parts of the horse. This is all done with the horse on the other side of the fence than the students. Then they have time to do an activity sheet based on what they have learned.

Archery – At archery the students will learn about safety in the archery area, how to string a bow, how to aim and shoot an arrow. The students will have lots of time to test out their skills and shooting ability. Archery takes place in an area all on its own and there are very strict rules that go with the activity.

Orienteering – During orienteering the students will learn the basics of how to use a compass, parts of a compass and how to follow a bearing. Then the students will navigate and travel all over camp to find clues to solve a problem. This is suggested for Grade 3 and up.

Team Building – Team building is a set of exercises that require the entire group's participation to solve. Team building gives the students the opportunity to develop their problem-solving skills, listening and cooperation skills, communication and creative thinking. Students will plan, discuss, set a goal and then participate as a group to accomplish the task at hand.

Frisbee Golf – This is a game much like mini golf, however it is played with a Frisbee and pylons. This will teach the students accuracy while allowing them to enjoy the outdoors and explore the ranch. This is an activity that is run by the parents of the group.

Scavenger Hunt – We have three different hunts that students can work away at. This is something that will help them with their numbers, and discover nature at U-Turn Ranch. This is suggested for Grade 3 and under.

Nature – This includes a walk and education on different ecosystems. This may include shelter building and discovery within our pond area, or a nature game.

U-TURN SCHOOL GROUP POLICIES

Please ensure that everyone attending is aware of U-turn Ranch School Group Policies below.

Reservations – Tentative dates may be set by phone, however no reservation is guaranteed until deposit and school group package is returned to U-Turn Ranch.

Cancellations – Deposits are non-refundable. There is no option of rescheduling due to weather. Please prepare students to come dressed for rain or shine.

Deposit & Payment - For all school groups we require there to be a non-refundable deposit. This will be credited to your final invoice, as long as there are no damages during your stay at U-Turn. Once school group package and deposit are received in our office, we will send out a confirmation. Two weeks prior to your arrival we ask that you contact us and let us know if your numbers are different than what is stated in this package. If we do not hear from you we will assume numbers are still the same. At that point we will send you a final invoice which is due upon arrival at the ranch. Checks may be used for deposit but we require cash or money order for final payment.

Release Forms - Please ensure that Release Forms are signed by every participant over 18 and everyone under 18 a parent or legal guardian must sign. This can be your school's standard form.

Meals – Our kitchen is not open for public use, so if meals are required U-turn Ranch and staff will provide all meals and clean up. We do have a fridge that you are welcome to use during your stay in the dining hall right outside the kitchen. Please ensure that no one enters the kitchen at any time.

Please ensure that your group follows all posted public health guidelines. We require that everyone wash their hands before eating, especially after handling animals.

Arrival /Departure – Our program generally runs 4 - 4 ½ hours. We can shorten it if necessary.

Alcohol, illegal drugs and restricted movies are not prohibited on the premises.

Smoking is prohibited in all building and around barn area. If this is something that is an issue for any member in your group please let us know and we will see if we can arrange a spot that is good for everyone.

Facility Care – School groups using U-Turn Ranch facilities are responsible for all damages beyond normal wear and tear to equipment, buildings, facilities and grounds, and will be charged accordingly.

Supervision – Groups are required to provide adequate supervision for participants at all times. U-Turn Ranch staff will be present to assist with serving meals, and while running activities. But we ask that an adult from your group be with every activity and present during meal time to supervise participants.

Nature & Wildlife – We ask that you let the nature of U-Turn Ranch not be disturbed. No cutting or removing twigs, leaves and bark from trees or picking flowers. We also ask that you respect all wildlife.

Garbage and Recycling – Garbage cans and blue boxes are available throughout the camp grounds. Please use them and do not litter.

Vehicles – All vehicles should be parked in the U-Turn Ranch parking lot. No speeding, driving vehicles in any area other than U-Turn Drive way and parking lot.

Pool – We attempt to have our pool up and running for the months of June – September. However, there is no guarantee. U-Turn Ranch will attempt to provide a lifeguard. If we can not find someone you are welcome to provide one, but we must have their qualifications on file for your stay and one of our staff is required to be at the pool at all times during swimming.

First Aid – School groups are responsible for their own first aid. We do have basic first aid supplies.

Fires – are permitted only in existing fire areas.

Lost and Found – U-Turn Ranch is not responsible for any lost or forgotten articles. Lost and found articles not claimed within two weeks may be donated to the local second hand store.

Out of Bounds – We ask that you keep your group out of the kitchen, barn and pastures, Ranch vehicles and equipment, private residences and program room. The pool and pond is closed unless arrangements have been made.

Accidents – We ask that any accidents or damage is reported to the directors of U-turn Ranch.
