Professor James F. Malec**

James is Professor and
Research Director in the
Department of Physical
Medicine and Rehabilitation,

Indiana University School of Medicine
and the Rehabilitation Hospital of
Indiana. He is a Professor Emeritus of
Psychology at the Mayo Clinic and is
Board Certified in Clinical
Neuropsychology and in Rehabilitation
Psychology through the American Board
of Professional Psychology. He has been
active in research and the clinical practice
of brain injury rehabilitation for over 35
years. He has received a number of
professional recognitions, including the
Lowman Award for interdisciplinary
contributions to rehabilitation from the
American Congress of Rehabilitation
Medicine and the Research Award of the
North American Brain Injury Society. He
has over 160 peer-reviewed publications
as well as other professional publications
and continues to conduct research in
brain rehabilitation and outcome
measurement.
