New Business

Preliminary proposal for Special Use: 6N098 Swanberg Road:

The committee reviewed a Special Use request by Jon and Terri Penner regarding the property at 6N098 Swanberg Road. Proposed special use of the property would include wedding/reception/events with an estimated maximum number of people to 250. An estimated average party size of 100 is anticipated. Proposal would employ site structures as they are with potential future upgrades.

As presented, the committee had found insufficient information within the proposal to formulate a recommendation to the Village board. Among the concerns:

- The Special Use Permit would require limits on the type of event, size of event, and hours of the event. The proposal does not provide specific details about the events and proposed site use.
- The proposal should include a business plan. A number of similar event locations exist (Fishermancs Inn, Goeberts, etc.) and one or more are undergoing improvements to attract business. The proposal does not indicate if research was done to determine the sustainability of this type of business.
- The proposal does not define improvements to the site only to say that the
 present structures will be used % is+ with on going upgrades. The
 proposal does not define the nature of the parking spaces and if
 improvements would be made for all-weather type parking surfaces.
