Youth Parents...

Please see the action items in red font. This week, the most important item in red is for parents to communicate back to me by Friday regarding the August Youth Lake day. ## A few quick announcements:

- During our call yesterday, the group voted on the following special activities for August. These will take place in addition to MYF and Tuesday calls.
- 1. Chick-Fil-A and devotion drop-off Friday, August 7th (drop-offs will occur sometime between 7 AM and 9 AM)
- 2. Virtual BINGO and Substation Tuesday, August 11th at 7 PM
- 3. Lake Day (more details below) Sunday, August 23rd from 3 PM to 8 PM
  - <u>Virtual devotion and prayer time on Tuesday, July 21st at 7 PM</u>: Originally we were not going to have a call on Tuesday since we were planning to volunteer at VBS. We will have a call since VBS is cancelled.
  - <u>Doughnut Devotion on Friday, July 24th:</u> We will drop off doughnuts and a devotion sometime between 7 am and 9 am. Most youth have already signed-up. Youth that have not signed up can do so during our Tuesday call.
  - <u>Church Family Postcards</u>: It's been a while since we've mailed cards/postcards to our church family. We've gotten numerous responses from our church family on how much it means to them to receive a card from the youth. We will be passing out 10 cards per youth along with doughnuts on Friday. There will be postcards, stamps, and an address list that should make this task pretty simple.
  - In-person MYF on Sunday, July 26th at 5:00 PM at the picnic shelter
  - **VBS:** I'm sure everyone has already received the communication that VBS has been cancelled for the time being. Thanks so much to everyone who was willing to volunteer their time at VBS!
  - Lake Day on August 23rd: The youth overwhelmingly voted to have another lake day as their August activity. We have reserved a house on Lake Wateree for August 23<sup>rd</sup> to host lake day. Youth would be able to fish, swim, kayak/canoe, ride in the boat, tube, etc. While we will have access to a house the idea is to keep all activities outdoors. We will provide snacks, grilled hotdogs and hamburgers, and make s'mores on the fire pit. I must know a firm headcount by this Friday (July 24<sup>th</sup>) in order to keep the reservation. If most youth are unavailable on this date, I will look to change this activity. Please communicate to me by Friday if your youth will be attending. This will also give us time to run this activity by the re-entry team.
  - <u>Other Outdoor Activities:</u> We are looking to help create a children's sensory garden in the small playground located on the church grounds. This is a project we will be organizing with Lisa Wilson and several other church members. More details to follow.
  - Immerse: Immerse camp at Asbury Hills from November 13-15. I will discuss this camp with the youth

and parents as we get closer to that time and as more details become available. See this link for the details that are available now.
