COVID-19 IP SAFETY AWARENESS POLICY

PURPOSE.

 To ensure that all employees and Interested parties connected with ST&L Consultancy and its business have sufficient provisions made to help reduce the risks associated whilst working during the COVID-19 pandemic.

SCOPE

All established and temporary employees working under a contract of service and all associated persons such as contractors, consultants and others employed under a contract for service. The Policy applies whilst these persons are on site and off site and whilst representing the Company during or outside working hours or attending Company sponsored functions.

- 1. The client has carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment of the site and working environment and has satisfactory procedures in place to ensure the safety of all visitors.
- 2. The ST&L Consultancy employee or sub-contractor has the necessary PPE with them which must be used and worn when on client's sites and consists of surgical gloves, hand sanitiser, face masks. This is in addition to any normal PPE that would be worn on client's sites.
- 3. Social distancing is followed when on site and all customers requirements concerning COVID-19 are followed.
- 4. If at any time the ST&L Consultancy employee or sub-contractor doesn't feel that safety measures are sufficient, they should contact Richard Jackman on 07896 781134 for guidance on the fulfilment of the site visit.
