# BEN SALEM VOICE



During the month of June the church dictates we will be leaving the season of Easter as we move into the season of Pentecost. We will stay in the season of Pentecost throughout the summer and into the fall until we reboot our church year and begin the Advent season once again. While the season of Pentecost is considered the season of growth and is a season that is needed, I must admit, I like the season of Easter because it is a season of joy as we talk about the grand and glorious thing God did in the resurrection of our Savior Jesus. Joy is something I think this world may be lacking as we consider the news of our day and the growing number of people suffering in states of misery and angst.

But really, while it may seem like people are less joyous these days what really is life? According to an obscure author named Frank R. Jennings, our life most certainly is filled by yin and yang. A little piece he wrote simply titled Life expresses this: "A little sunshine, a little rain, a little loss, a little gain, a little happiness, a little pain, not all sweet, not all sour, now a weed, now a flower; a Godly average of sunshine and shower." You see, joy is never far from angst. It is how life has been created. Maybe consider this, if we didn't know evil how would we know the goodness of God?

An English poet you may have heard of - William Blake spent his life writing poetry, painting and dabbling as a printmaker during the 19<sup>th</sup> century. One piece he wrote puts it this way: "Joy and woe are woven fine, a clothing for the soul divine; under every grief and pine runs a joy with silken twine; it is right it should be so; Man was made for joy and woe; and when this we rightly know safely through the world we go."

So as we go through this month of June know that even if you happen to be experiencing times when you feel disillusioned or discouraged or maybe even distressed, joy is just on the other side of that angst. Joy is always nearby, because that is how God created this world to be. Joy can be found, especially during this season of summer, as the splendors of our surroundings captivate us. During the summer, even in the midst of our angst, our senses are aroused as we hear the crescendo of birds singing their songs all the while witnessing the fine creation of color and beauty. And as we step outside and feel the warmth of the summer sun on our bodies it can feel as if we are receiving a hug from God. These are all things that can help us overcome our angst and move us to joy as we come to the realization of how much we are loved. So as I conclude this letter I want to leave you with a prayer to remember and pray during this season of growth. It is a short prayer that has a poetic quality and was written by a man who is simply known as B. Y. Williams. *Oh, not for more or longer days, dear Lord, my prayer shall be – but rather teach me how to use the days now given me. I ask not more of pleasure or joy for this brief while – but rather let me for the joys I have, Be Glad and Smile.*

### <u>Cemetery Association Officers</u>: <u>Reminder</u> <u>from Cemetery Association</u>:

Guidelines for placing flowers and floral arrangements on the Ben Salem Cemetery

1. All types of real or potted plants are acceptable. Please remove colored foil from potted plant containers before placement. Any type of trees are <u>not</u> acceptable in the cemetery.

2. We ask that no artificial flowers and arrangements be placed on our cemeteries from May 1 through October 31.

3. Prior to placement of Christmas arrangements, make certain that artificial pieces are securely fastened to the arrangement. \**All Christmas arrangements should be removed from gravesites by March 1<sup>st</sup> weather permitting.* 

4. Appropriate signs for the guidelines will be placed at the cemeteries.

5. As a courtesy to persons living away from the area, floral arrangements may be placed at gravesites

by contacting the Cemetery Association.

6. After April 30<sup>th</sup>, the Cemetery Association will remove artificial arrangements.

7. Solar powered decorative sticks are acceptable at gravestones.


### Richard and Cynthia Smith Scholarship Fund:

Applications for the Smith Scholarship Fund can be obtained by calling the Church Office at 570-386-3870. The forms can be sent in the mail or e-mailed to those who wish to apply. This fund was established to assist high school graduates who are furthering their education. The applicant must be a member in good standing of Ben Salem UCC. The applicant must have graduated from high school and be enrolled as a full time, undergraduate student in an accredited college or technical school to further his/her education. A person may only be a recipient of this scholarship one time but if you have applied in a prior year and not been a recipient of the scholarship, you may apply again. Preference will be given to those who have a financial need, who are loyal to the church, its worship and life, and who have performed community service. Applications should be submitted to the Church Office by June 30, 2019.

# Ham and Dandelion Dinner


I would like to take this opportunity to Thank everyone who helped in any way to make our Ham and Dandelion dinner a booming success.
