## ***From the Pastor's Desk***

Dear brothers and sisters,

Lent has arrived! This wonderful season of reconciliation and breaking with sin so that we can get closer to God and enjoy the promises that He made to us at our Baptism. Lent has no meaning on its own; only when it is against the backdrop of Easter then it acquires meaning and beauty. Lent is a time to recognize that we did not live our Baptismal Vocation and thus we get another chance to break away with what is tying us up in this life so that we can at Easter renew our Baptismal promises and start living the life that God has intended for us since the beginning. The Gospel of today presents to us the Temptations of Christ in the desert. In them, all our struggles are present. We struggle for security and control, we want God and life to do certain things and follow a plan or what we would like and we find many times in the grasp of frustration and anger because it does not go that way; we struggle with our thoughts as to what and how we should be and how we need to accomplish that and also that brings us to frustration. Finally, we all struggle to trust that God can provide for our needs and that is where money comes in the mix and we get attached because of fear. For all that God wants to give us freedom – so let us practice the remedy given to us prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

We will start the Stations of the Cross this week on Friday at 7 pm in the Church. We will do a Bible Study on Friday March 20 at 6:30 PM in Mother Angela and please attend our Penance Service on March 9 at 7 PM in Church.


