As you can see by the events calendar I have a few workshops already planned for this year.

I will be teaching two workshops and one demonstration at The Stitching Circle in Mt Barker. The Overlocking for all levels workshops is always popular with students. It covers the basics like threading and maintenance of your machine through understanding the stitch pattern and tension adjustments, rolled hemming and flat-locking and a number of decorative techniques with fancy threads. There is a complete workbook included for all your samples and tension notes. Freehand Machine embroidery teaches beginners how to work the

Freehand Machine embroidery teaches beginners how to work the machine freehanded using straight and zig zag stitch. We will also cover monogramming, sewing through open spaces, decorative threads in the bobbin case, tension and bobbin tension adjustments and thread painting.

The FREE demonstration will be all about the Needle Felting Machine which Carol now sells at the Stitching Circle. I will have lots of sample to see and will show a variety of finishes achievable with an Embellisher. If you wanted to see what they actually do come along for an hour.

I hope to participate in 3 major exhibitions this year. "Essence" in July with the Fan group. This is a portrait themed textile exhibition with members exploring the essence of themselves.

In October is Dare to Differ, which I hope to have two works in. One is on the way as you can see in my blog spopecreations@blogspot.com. And finally the Murraylands Arts & Crafts Collective is having an exhibition in November called "Home Away from Home" in Murray Bridge.

Southern Textiles is on in October this year and since the last newsletter there has been a change of workshop. Julie Haddrick's workshop Paint Pizzaz has been replaced by Exploring Surface Design & Stitch with Suzanne Gummow. Having done workshops with both Prudence Mapstone and Carol Wilkes I can recommend both tutors highly.


